Fitting is a free service so use our expertise to ensure you buy the best possible fitting suit. All you need do is include some of your measurements per the diagram to the left and we will ensure you order a correct fitting suit.

Some important rules about this size chart:

- > A snug fitting suit is better than a lose fitting suit.
- > Your chest should receive priority so it is not too tight
- > If you are in upper limits of hight, keep to mid/lower limits of other measurements
- > If you are in lower limits of hight, keep to mid/high limits of other measurements
- > Sizes are not consistant between brands, nor even between models of the same brand.
- > Sizes are not consistant between neoprene thickness. A 5mm suit is less flexible than a 3mm suit.
- > Minimum & Maximums provided may be exceeded but you should contact us first for guidance
